This tragedy has opened many doors of opportunity for local churches and Christian organizations. Bill has been working with pastors, youth pastors, and Christian teenagers to plan and organize community events and assemblies to reach the youth of Campbell County with the hope that Jesus Christ has to offer. Please be in prayer for assemblies that are scheduled at the High Schools on April 28th.

We have been asked to be a part of a 3-day Children's Health Fair. We will have the opportunity to speak to every elementary age student in Campbell County on the subject of "bullying".
