The Summer Camping Program is the primary ministry at Galilee Bible Camp. Our purpose is to use guest speakers, Bible stories, Scripture memory, drama, skits, lively music, videos, and outdoor activities to make learning about a loving Creator God easy and fun!

We do not endorse or depreciate any particular church affiliation but study the Bible emphasizing an individual response to Christ!

Who may attend Summer Bible Camp? Any child or young person from the ages of 5 through Graduation. We want to minister to all ages! That means adults, too! Although, we do not have a week of camp for adults, we encourage adults to participate in the Summer Bible Camp ministry. We are sure you will be blessed as you volunteer a week of your time with the campers.

The staff is comprised of individuals who volunteer their time in many aspects. The duties range from cabin leader, recreational director, Bible teacher, crafts, music director, staff child care, cooking, or cleaning. We also have the privilege of having several AMF missionaries working with the camp missionaries during the camping weeks.

An average day at Summer Bible Camp consists of rising with the bell and preparing for Daily Quiet Time. This gives the campers time to have their daily time alone with God. We also have a Bible class each day. There is time for scripture memory, Bible drills, and quizzing. The campers also have an opportunity to learn more about missions. There is recreation, swimming, crafts, and snack times at the Sugar Shack. Three healthy and fulfilling meals are provided each day too! One of the most important times of the day is our evening chapel. We worship the Lord with songs and have a speaker share from Gods word. After Chapel there is a variety of activities planned, including games, videos, campfire and skits. The campers then get ready for bed and evening devotions with their cabin. Then LIGHTS OUT for a good nights rest!

## **WHAT TO BRING – PLEASE MARK CAMPER'S NAME ON ALL ITEMS!**

- Your Bible, pen, paper, pillow, sleeping bag or sheets & blanket, sweater, pajamas, towels, wash cloths, toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, comb/brush, and any personal items that may be needed.
- All Campers must wear modest swimsuits and a T-shirt to cover. Girls—Bring one piece swimsuits.
- Bring clothing and shoes suitable for outdoors, recreation, and hiking.
- You may wish to bring \$ for the Sugar Shack and evening offering (optional). No money needed for Day Camp.
- Feel free to bring friends!
- Leave all portable music systems, video games, cell phones, pagers, food, snacks, and drinks *at home!* If you forget and bring any of these items, we will safely keep them for you until your departure!

## **CAMP RULES – READ CAREFULLY!**

- Campers must keep entire camp schedule.
- Personal conduct must be compatible with Christian ideals for camp, which exclude the use of tobacco, alcohol, and drugs.
- No magazines, music players, cell phones, food, snacks, or drinks.
- Shoes must be worn when out of doors except during water activities. All clothing must be modest in appearance. Modest shorts are permitted during the recreational and day activities.
- MIDDLE/SR HIGH—Your shirts must cover your waist. No spaghetti straps or tank tops are permitted. All Campers must wear modest swimsuits and a T-shirt to cover. Girls—Bring one piece swimsuits. Shorts are not acceptable for evening services. Girls - Skirts or dresses are preferred.
- Campers need to be cleaned up for evening chapel services in reverence of God.
- Misconduct may result in the camper being sent home.
- No camper shall leave the camp property without receiving permission from the camp director.
- Other guidelines will be announced as needed to provide a wholesome program for all campers.
- All accidents, no matter how minor, must be reported.
- Campers must agree to the above rules and sign the application under your parent's signature.

## **DIRECTIONS TO THE CAMP**

- Take 1-75 Exit 134 (LaFollette/Caryville/Jacksboro) to Hwy 25W North/63 East.
- Take Hwy 25W North/63 East toward LaFollette.
- Travel 6 miles to Hunter Branch Road and turn right. Travel 6/10 mile and turn right at Cedar Hill Baptist Church onto Demory Road. Travel 5-5/10 miles, bear left at storage buildings, continuing on Demory Road. Follow Camp Galilee signs 1 4/10 mile.
- Turn right on Camp Galilee Road, go 5/10 of a mile. The camp drive is on the right.
- You will see the Galilee Bible Camp sign at the drive entrance.
