## **Junior Worker Responsibilities and Possible Jobs**

1. A junior worker will follow all the rules of the camp and its dress code.
2. A junior worker will help in the kitchen before and after meals, washing off the tables, doing dishes, sweeping floors, etc.
3. A junior worker will help clean the bathrooms on the camp every day during camp. He/she will be shown the proper way it needs to be done.
4. A junior worker will help take out the trash.
5. A junior worker will help with the canteen time.
6. A junior worker will be a good example in his/her behavior to the campers.
7. A junior worker will have a daily quiet time (booklets will be provided).
8. A junior worker needs to be in his/her cabin by 9:30 p.m.
9. A junior worker needs to check the job lists posted each day with times for the jobs to be done and by whom. These lists will be posted on the bulletin board in the dining hall.
10. A junior worker will wash his/her hands every time they enter the dining hall before beginning an assigned task.
11. A junior worker will attend evening chapel unless permission not to do so is received from Bill or Brenda Bennett.
12. A junior worker is entitled to get 2 free items (only 1 soda) from the Sugar Shack each time the canteen is offered on the schedule.
