PARENT VISITATION & CALLING

OUR STAFF

Our summer camps are staffed with trained volunteers who are excited about bonding with and sharing Jesus with our campers. Cabin staff stay in the cabins with their assigned group of campers and will guide and encourage their campers throughout the week. We have approximately 5:1 camper to staff ratio at each camp with background checks run on all adult workers. We always have a staff member on-site who is certified in CPR and First Aid and a certified lifeguard on duty during lake activities.

WHAT TO BRING

Closed-toed shoes & pants (for horseback riding)

Water shoes

Beach Towel

Swim suit and cover up (no 2 piece suits/see dress code)

Change of clothing (see dress code)

Prescription medications (check-in at first aid station)

Sunscreen

Bug spray

Life vest (if you have one)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Cell phone, other electronics, or camera
Over-the-counter medication
Books or magazines
Weapons (including pocket knives)
Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or other illegal substances
Food or drinks of any kind

Happy Camping

DRESS CODE

Shirts: Shirt and shorts must overlap when reaching arms straight above head and when leaning over to touch toes. Shirt must cover chest when bending over (no low cut tops). Tank tops must be at least the width of three fingers.

Shorts: Inseam must be at least 5 inches in length. (if not sure, hold arms straight down with shoulders relaxed and hands against your legs -shorts must be lower than your fingertips.) Or parents will be called to bring appropriate shorts

Swim wear: Girls must wear a 1-piece swim suit or tankini that overlaps. Any swimsuits that do not meet this criteria will be worn with a dark t-shirt & shorts. Boys must wear modest swim trunks. (Everyone Must wear T-shirts to & from lake)
